## Most Likely Best Group of 5 School:

# **Concerns with my Playoff Predictions:**

- 1. **Va Tech** This could easily be a reach. Momentum at the end of the previous season doesn't always relate to success the next year. I believe that Clemson and Miami will not live up to the pre-season hype this year. I could easily be wrong with that theory though. I also worry about the game against Rutgers this year.
- 2. **Texas-** I have Texas winning the SEC and Natty. This could mean that Texas has to play Georgia 3 times. I don't know if

it's likely Georgia loses to the same team 3 times in one season. Texas is also historic for having at least one or two games where they just play terribly.

- 3. **Florida State** FSU has lost a lot of people from last year's squad. They did a great job in the portal but saying that the chemistry is going to be there is still unknown. There are some analysts who think they will struggle to win 8 games this year. I am not one of those people.
- 4. Penn State- Franklin is on the "hot seat"..this team is notorious for always finding a way to lose at least 2 games in the regular season. The schedule is tougher this year. Does 10-2 even get you in the playoffs this year? I'm not sure it does. While I like PSU, I am not feeling 100% they go 11-1 or better.
- 5. **SEC At-Large-** This is going to be tricky. You have so many legit teams in this conference. I have learned during the Saban days that you never bet against Bama. Yet, I have Bama losing 3 games and not going to the playoffs. I think they made a great hire at HC but they also lost a ton in the portal. The other question is...how many SEC schools will get selected?
- 6. Best of Group of 5- Some of the better Group of 5 schools play some really tough non-conference games that I don't think they win. How much stock is given to a school like Texas State who I think might go 12-0 with a school like Memphis who I think could go 11-1 but has a loss to Florida State? I believe there will be several schools in the discussion.
- 7. **Indy Schools** How does the committee handle Notre Dame and possibly Oregon State? Oregon State got shafted by

Conference Realignment. If they were to go 11-1 do they get consideration? I know the media LOVES Notre Dame but how many losses can they survive with? If they go 10-2 do they still get into the playoffs?
